Please plan on reading regularly to your child. Use the reading log to keep a record of the books you have read to your child. Also, over the summer, please choose three different books that were especially enjoyable. Help your child to write a book report about these books.

I recommend reading books by Dr. Seuss like **The Cat in the Hat** and **Green Eggs and Ham**. These books will help sharpen skill in rhyming. Try reading **If You Give a Mouse a Cookie** and **If You Give a Moose a Muffin** by Numeroff and Felicia Bond. These books help sharpen the skill of reading in context. To review basic sight words with your child look for level one books like the series by Alyssa Satin Capucilli like **Biscuit** and **Biscuit Finds a Friend**.

Please send back the work your child has completed in September. Thank you for your cooperation! Enjoy your reading!

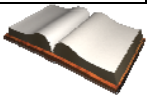
